<b>Friday – 20 May 2011</b>	
	Fly to Kimberley out of Johannesburg. Collect vehicle if arranged from Budget Rent a Car and collect map. Drive through to Lime Acres ("die Boom"), approx 255kms from airport. Some of you may drive directly from Gauteng, if so, map attached.
15h00 – 18h30	<p>Arrive at "Die Boom" at Lime Acres</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Susan du Plessis will be at "Die Boom" – find out from her where you will be accommodated. She will also provide you with directions.</li> <li>– Your Team Leader will have contacted you in the course of the week (between Monday and Thursday) to make arrangements for the loading of vehicles.</li> <li>– Depending on your team's loading arrangements, you can drive to the guest house where you will be staying and settle in. Daniëlskuil is about 25km from "Die Boom", Lime Acres village about 3km.</li> </ul>
18h30	<p>Pre-supper drinks will be at "Die Boom". We have chosen white wines and red wines to be enjoyed by sponsors. The host companies will pay for these wines, local beers and soft drinks. <b>Limited spirits will be available.</b></p> <p>This is an outdoor venue and all guests are advised to dress warmly.</p>
19h00	<p>Dinner will be in the form of an informal braai around the lapa.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Guests are requested to be seated at 19h00 (tables will be allocated per team)</li> <li>– Con Schoombie, Executive Lime Operations will do the official welcoming of guests.</li> <li>– READ will provide guests with a brief overview of the READ programme over the next three years.</li> <li>– During dinner Team Leaders will brief their respective teams on the detail arrangements for Saturday, 21 May 2011.</li> </ul> <p>Overnight in at nearby B&amp;B's in Lime Acres or Daniëlskuil.</p>
<b>Saturday – 21 May 2011</b>	
06h30	<p>Breakfast at "Die Boom"</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teams 1, 2, 5 and 6 – it is important for these teams to be at the breakfast not later than 06h30.</li> <li>• Teams 3 and 4 are requested to have their breakfast as from 07h15, since they have less travelling to do.</li> </ul>
07h30	<p>Leave in teams for visits to 2 or 3 schools in the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– This will be our first visit to these schools</li> <li>– We will deliver books for all grades at the respective schools</li> <li>– There will be a short presentation at each school; a symbolic signing of the annual contract between the school and the project; and a tour of the school. The school expects us to stay for just less than an hour.</li> </ul> <p>A packed picnic lunch will be enjoyed during the day.</p> <p>In the event of a medical emergency – team leaders will have a basic first aid kit in their vehicles.</p>
13h00 – 17h00	<p>Arrival back from visit to schools.</p> <p>Entrance to the Bonza Game farm have been arranged from 15h00. Guests interested in participating should give an indication to their team leader on the Friday evening and arrangements will be communicated.</p>
18h30	<p>Pre-supper drinks will be at the Lime Acres Recreational Club. Wines, local beers and soft drinks will be paid by the sponsors. <b>A cash bar will be available for spirits.</b></p>

19h00	Gala dinner will take place on Saturday evening. Your Co-Ordinator will MC the evenings proceedings and we will have an opportunity to hear feedback from each teams on the days activities at the rally schools.
